- ◆ *Summary*

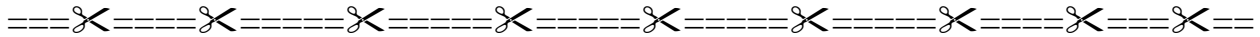
